22/96. Update on Highways issues – email has been sent to highways to request if they would consider a solid white line approaching junction of Norwich Road with Sweetbriar Lane. Clerk to ask for verge to be cut around the white gates near the Pigs. Footpaths need replacing and restoring Clerk to meet with Cllr Cletheroe.

Update needed on the flooding on the main road to Ramsgate Street as August is approaching and the PC is unaware that any action has been taken. Clerk to invite the Anglian Water to the next meeting and check on Roger Allsop for any updates. Also Clerk to contact highways re flooding on the main road.

It is suggested that the grass should be cut as & when needed by Phil Borley and not be allowed to grow too long. Proposed HM, Seconded LP. The hedges need cutting around the bins & village Hall, this can be done at the same time the grass is cut.
